University graduates earn more on average than non-graduates. In 2022, the median weekly earnings for full-time employees aged 22-64 with a degree was £661, compared to £478 for those without a degree. (Source: ONS)

University graduates are more likely to be in employment. In 2022, the employment rate for people aged 25-34 with a degree was 94.8%, compared to 81.4% for those without a degree. (Source: ONS)

University graduates are more likely to be satisfied with their jobs. In 2022, 88.5% of people aged 25-34 with a degree were satisfied with their jobs, compared to 78.3% of those without a degree. (Source: ONS)
