Mon 23 October, 11-12.30: HALLOWEEN CROSS STITCH with Jane Browne
Create a Halloween motif in cross stitch with Jane Browne, the Surrey Artist of the Year 2022. There will be a choice of image and all materials will be provided including needle and threads. Tue 24 October, 11-12.30: PAPER MAKING with Charlotte Karin Design
Learn to make paper; the children will have a brief introduction into preparing scrap paper and making it into pulp before immersing themselves into the active part of making paper by hand. They will be layering different types of textured paper and create compositions by trapping materials between surfaces. Dried leaves from walks around Farnham to press into the paper to emboss or embellish will be provided.
