Poverty is hidden in plain sight in Surrey. Although we live in one of the least deprived parts of the country we have small pockets of deprivation where families fall into the poorest 30% of the UK. The increase in poverty, the use of food banks, homelessness and mental distress increases the risk of domestic violence, substance misuse and child neglect. With poverty comes poverty of spirit; of self-esteem, stigma, isolation and depression. We are asking for your help as a school community to contribute a Christmas gift to a local child who otherwise will not be receiving one this Christmas. Waverley Children's Services will distribute the gifts to the families and children they work 1:1 with and will send "a sleigh" of gifts around the estates of Upper Hale. Please do get your children involved - ask for their contribution and what they think their peers might like to receive? The children range in age from 0-15. All contributions are welcome!!
