

OUR COMMITMENT DURING A NATIONAL LOCKDOWN

We will be taking a tailored approach to Remote learning depending on the age of the children. This will be constantly under review and we will look at the needs of the children to make sure they are able to access the core curriculum and the foundation subjects as much as is possible. We acknowledge that online learning is more challenging for the younger students but our dedicated, experienced staff will guide them to make them feel supported and connected to their peers and learning as much as possible.

LIVE LESSONS

Our Remote Lessons will be taught via Microsoft Teams. To ensure our students have a focus on the core subjects of English and Maths they are taught in the mornings when the children are fresher. The live lessons allow time for the teaching and also the chance to work collaboratively with their peers. They will be sent any requirements of items they might need for their lesson ahead of time. Where appropriate work will be marked via Teams Assignments for Year 6 and Seesaw for Year 5 and below.

SET ACTIVITIES

The children in Reception - Year 5 have their independent activities set on Seesaw. The introduction of these activities is either done in the live lesson or as an uploaded video. We are encouraging children to try and complete tasks on Seesaw as independently as possible. Year 6 have their independent work set on Teams under assignments (similar to the Middle School).

TIMETABLED REMOTE LEARNING:


NURSERY (IF ALL AT HOME)

- Live catch up with staff three times a week
- Story reading from teachers uploaded to watch on Seesaw
- Short activities to complete for Foundation areas of learning

RECEPTION

- Live Maths/English/Phonics lesson every day (lasting about 20-30 minutes)
- 1:1 catch ups with each child once a week (those who are not onsite)
- 3 set activities on Seesaw every day and follow up from live lessons
- 1:1 reading sessions with a TA online once a week

YEAR 1

- Live Maths, English or Phonics lesson every day (lasting about 20-30 minutes)
 - Live foundation subject lesson in the afternoon four times a week
 - 3 set activities on Seesaw every day and follow up from live lessons
 - 1:1 catch ups with each child once a week (those who are not onsite)
 - 1:1 reading sessions with a TA online once a week
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YEARS 2 AND 3

- Live Maths lessons every day 20-30 minutes
- Live English lesson every day 20-30 minutes
- Followed by activities to complete on Seesaw
- Live foundation subject lessons twice a day and activity to complete during the session or afterwards
- 1:1 reading sessions with a TA online once a week
- 1:1 catch ups with children once every few weeks to check in

YEARS 4 5 6

- Live Maths lessons every day 30 minutes
- Live English lesson every day 30 minutes
- Followed by activities to complete on Seesaw
- Live foundation subject lessons twice a day and activity to complete during the session or afterwards
- 1:1 reading sessions with a TA online once a week for Year 4 and other children who need support
- 1:1 catch ups with children once every few weeks to check in

OUR COMMITMENT TO STUDENTS WHO ARE SELF-ISOLATING, WHEN NOT IN A LOCKDOWN

In the event of a whole bubble being sent home to isolate we will move to the same Remote Learning offered during a lockdown. This will include the Core subjects taught by the class teacher. We may not be able to offer as many foundation subjects as staff will be also teaching onsite.

If an individual child is absent because their household is isolating, then the class teacher will provide work for the child to complete in the Core subjects to keep them abreast of learning. The class teacher will organise an individual weekly catch up on Teams. We are unable to offer live lessons throughout the day.
